Called Meeting of Church-in-Conference on August 25, 2019

A specially called meeting of the Church-in-Conference will be held on Sunday, August 25, 2019 in the Fellowship Hall after the morning worship service. The purpose of the meeting is to consider a recommendation from the Steeple Replacement Ad Hoc Committee to install a new structure on our Sanctuary Building to replace the steeple that collapsed on June 1, 2018. The members of this committee are Jordan Clark (chair), Susan Dew, Walter Grant, Randy Korando, and Josh Mudd.

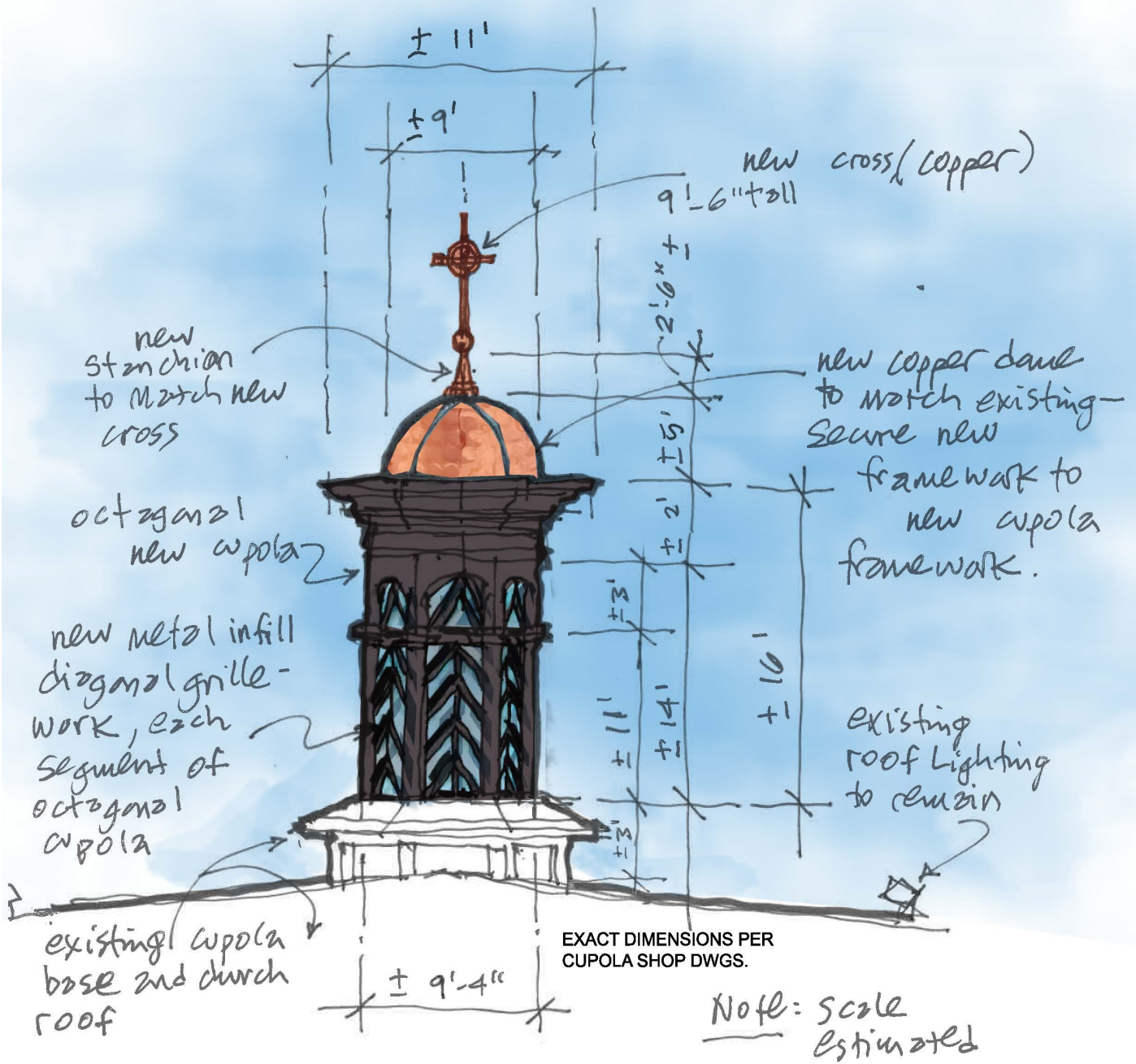
The ad hoc committee has recommended that we install an octagonal metal cupola topped with a copper dome and a new Celtic cross identical to the cross that was on the original steeple. In proposing this new structure, the committee consulted with the architectural firm of Gary Coursey & Associates, which prepared a drawing of the cupola, dome, and cross now on display in the Fellowship Hall.

As part of its work on this project, the ad hoc committee obtained a quote of \$65,832 from Campbellville Industries, Inc. of Campbellville, Kentucky (the firm that designed and manufactured our original steeple) to fabricate and install the new structure and also obtained quote of \$38,175 from Lusk & Company of Atlanta to provide services as the general contractor for the project. With the addition of architectural design fees, the total projected cost of the project is \$110,000, which will include installation of the new structure and removal of the structurally unsound steeple base that remains on the Sanctuary Building. Insurance proceeds will be used to fund the cost of the project and to install a new asphalt roof that was damaged by the steeple's collapse.

The replacement structure has been approved by the NDBC Trustees and the Church Council and is supported by Senior Pastor James Lamkin and Associate Pastor Daniel Headrick. Please join us for the called meeting of the Church-in-Conference on August 25 to discuss and vote on the ad hoc committee's recommendation.
