The Lecture Series has been rebooted! Thank God; and thanks be to Malcolm and Lea McComb.

For newcomers to NDBC, Gladys and Tom McComb were characters. I said at Gladys Greer McComb's funeral, "Not only was Gladys a reader of novels, she was novel!" She was a feisty trail-mix of the profane and profound, the secular and the sacred. Those combos made her winsome... and as she would say, "A good sinner."

Tom was a bit quieter; but he was an astute scholar, a voracious reader, and a "noteless" lecturer par excellence. His curiosity was wide-ranging.

After Gladys's death, he began a lectureship in her honor. It provided an annual forum for friends and family to remember an unusual woman who challenged/gifted/loved us into a bigger life.

I always told Tom, and I've told Malcolm, that these lectures were very much a part of our church's destiny. Our stated vision requires us to listen, not only to ancient texts, but also to today's headlines.

Tom recruited experts on a multitude of topics, from Egyptology to astrophysics, from Christianity as a collegial religion to race relations as an academic challenge, from the power of music to the history of opera. Not a routine topic to be had. Last year, I invited a snake handling author!

This year, Dr. David Shi, former president of Furman University, will speak on: "The Pursuit of Happiness." A blue ribbon committee has invited him and will be hosting him.

Once again, the McComb family is making this gift possible. So, join us...somewhere between The Big Bang and The Big Ending, Northside Drive Baptist Church perches with poise on the space/time continuum. We are good stewards of our small walk-on part in the great drama of God. Grateful am I that Gladys and Tom McComb were part of our flock. They were characters with character.
