

Pastoral Reflections

"Someone's Missing Lord"



Louise Davis was our last charter member. She was one of the first to join; and she was the last one to die on January 31, 2018. She was the Alpha and Omega of the Class of '52 wrote their names on the dotted line and said, "I'm all in."

I still watch for her on "her pew" every Sunday. Kinda expect her to walk in and ask, "Can you believe this?" Well, no. I can't.

When her obituary appeared in the AJC, Terrell Kilgore was the first to add a comment: "You will be truly missed. I have enjoyed every time with you at church."

Years ago, Dr. Vincent Harding, speechwriter for Martin Luther King, Jr., preached a funeral homily for three young civil rights workers who were murdered in Mississippi. The ragged grief was heard in the families' weeping and wailing. Yet, in the service, they also sang; and what they sang said it all, "Someone's missing Lord. Kum-Ba-Yah. Someone's missing Lord. Kum-Ba-Yah."

Here's my Lenten confession: Sometimes, I think I've outgrown Kum-Ba-Yah. But, shame on me for doing so. Few lyrics ache-out their truth so eloquently. When we can't put one foot in front of the other, when our prayers drop to the floor like wingless doves, when all we can do is to muster a whisper and sing, "Oh, Lord, come by here," it is enough.


May God bless the memory of Louise Davis. (She claimed it was her prayers that prompted NDBC's baby boom over the last five years.) May God bless the investment of Louise Davis. (She poured in all she had to the birthing and the doing of our church...sometimes gracefully, sometimes willfully, but all the time, completely!) Her love was never far away. As I would prepare to leave her many "death beds," she often would hand me a church envelope and say, "This is my offering. Would you drop it in the plate on Sunday?"

Though it will take a dozen of us to replace her; we will still fall short. But, we can bring ourselves and give ourselves and watch for those times when God does Kum-Ba-Yah. And even though someone's missing, God always is present and comes near.
