

Caitlyn Cook-Furr will be completing her practicum requirement this summer for her Master of Public Health. She has accepted a position in Canada, conducting research on HPV vaccination rates amongst the First Native population and formulating an intervention to increase the vaccination rate. For the Fall semester, Caitlyn will be studying abroad in Kenya through a partnership between the Candler School of Theology and St. Paul's University. She will be studying Muslim/Christian relations through St. Paul's Theology Program. Caitlyn will also be working on a public health project where she will engage local faith leaders to help reduce the stigma of HIV testing in remote villages throughout Kenya.

Motion for Proposed Amendments to NDBC Bylaws

A motion to amend the Bylaws of Northside Drive Baptist Church, Inc. will be presented to the Church-in-Conference at its meeting on May 24, 2018, at 6:45 pm.

The motion will be presented by the Bylaws Review Committee, an ad hoc committee appointed by the Moderator to review the Bylaws and recommend any changes thereto.

The Committee moves that the church approve the following amendments to the NDBC Bylaws. A redlined version of a hard copy will be made available at the meeting.

The Adult Education Committee is planning a 2018 Summer Series called "Fumbling Toward Faith." The series approaches catechesis (basic Christian instruction for believers) as less of a question about "what" we believe and more a question of "why" we believe. In short, "why does it matter that we believe these tenets of faith at all?" For each doctrinal topic, our presenters are invited to talk about the questions which keep them up at night. Topics include authority, sin, salvation, the human condition, ecclesiology, baptism, and communion.

There will also be some "surprise" lectures by Dr. Jim Mahaffey. Be looking for more details in the very near future.
