Pastoral Reflection

"This is the Day the Lord hath Made"
By: James Lamkin



"This is the day." One of the psalmists said that. Said that *today*...this very day...was made by God. But, the poet didn't stop there. The Lord's "made day," invites a response. So, "Let us rejoice and be glad in it."

I wonder how many days the writer practiced that...the *rejoice* and *be glad* part...before it felt true? Maybe he said it day after day even though he waded knee deep in the *Slough of Despond*. Maybe he said it when his heart was breaking. Maybe he said it when his heart was broken open. Maybe he said it often enough, that one day, in spite of himself, it became true.

My colleagues and I work hard at worship. We plan. We pray. We study. We listen. We learn. We attend to the drama of liturgy with its adoration of God, its confession of sin, its thanksgiving for redeeming love, and its prayers on the behalf of others. We worship a resourceful God with a deep bench: silence and shouts, longing and laughter, sermons and songs, young kids and old folks.

We work hard at worship...but we can't make worship happen. It is like "the day." The Lord has to make it. We can experience it as a gift, but we can't magically make it.

For me, this past Sunday was one of those days that "the Lord hath made." I'm not sure of the Holy Spirit's formula. The alchemy was one-part Daniel, one-part MaryLou, and a heaping helping of band-aid-toting Good Samaritan Helpers. It was one-part music with me occupying the Fisher Alberson endowed chair of handbell acuity. It was a story told about Dignity Church, Washington, DC... a gay Roman Catholic Church that meets just off Dupont Circle, and how it broke open my heart. It was Melinda, our interim organist, who blends right in. It was Jackie Poole, worship leader, who prays better than most priests I know.

And...and...it was the 93 people who showed-up for lunch. (God multiplied the 38 who made reservations.) We visited and ate. We listened and affirmed. We imagined a pavilion soon to be built near the chapel; and it will be large enough to host the first ever *Lois Peacock Memorial Square Dance*.

And we voted to work at pledging the 2019 budget. Liz and I will turn in our Pledge Card first. Get in line and join us.

In the rearview mirror, Sunday was a day that the Lord hath made. I rejoiced and was glad in it. Then again, how could I have done otherwise?


