## Pastoral Reflection "Gratitude and Giving" By: James Lamkin



John McIntyre used to say, "The Bible says, 'God loves a cheerful giver'; but we'll take money from a grouch!"

I still chuckle at that...and I still think of George Smith when I do. In fact, John and George were both NDBC Trustees back-in-the-day. Each year about now, I like to reprint an article I had written about George.

He was a natural businessman. He could dive to the bottom line of a budget faster than an Acapulco cliff-diver. George was not gloomy...but he tended to live on that end of the spectrum.

Even if he was one part *gloomy*, he was at least ten parts *generous*. Generosity drew him to his favorite holiday: Thanksgiving. One day a year, George would shed his sadness, and put on an ear-to-ear smile.
