Pastoral Reflections

"Pavilioned in Splendor"



Though hard to believe, we soon will break ground for the long-awaited pavilion. It will look like hope.

Years ago, JB Gilbert got the ball rolling. Then, a lot of folk pushed along the way, Josh Mudd being one of them. Under its roof, kids can play, Church School classes can meet, EEE can share a meal, wedding knots can be tied, funerals can be had, a Kurt Thomas concert can be picked and sung, plus a Lois Peacock memorial square dance can be danced. Yes, soon we will be *pavilioned*.

Every time I think about it, I hear the lyrics of a familiar hymn in my head: *O Worship the King*. The hymnwriter was Sir Robert Grant. He described God as being, "...our shield and defender, the Ancient of Days, *pavilioned in splendor* and girded with praise."

I'm sure a square dance under an open building's roof is not what Sir Robert Grant, a 19th Brit through-and-through, had in mind with *pavilioned*. But, I figure God is *pavilioned* enough already. I think God can share some with us.

Robert Grant's father was a leader in the evangelical wing of the Church of England. He assisted William Wilberforce in the emancipation of slaves in the British Empire. This brave and long-suffering act of love must have influenced young Robert. His song sings of judgment with *God's chariots of wrath*; but it also affirms divine grace as *God's bountiful care*.

My favorite stanza is the last. I reference it every **Ash Wednesday**. Not only does it claim that we are *frail dust*; it names that we are held by *tender mercies*.

*Frail children of dust and feeble as frail,
in thee do we trust, nor find thee to fail.*

*Thy mercies, how tender, how firm to the end,
our Maker, Defender, Redeemer, and Friend.*

I give thanks that we all shall soon be *pavilioned*: old and young, frail and strong, singers and sitters and dancers. I give thanks that we always are *pavilioned* under God's tender mercies. I give thanks.

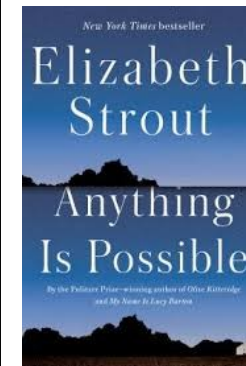
