Pastoral Reflections "Easter for the <u>Discombobulated</u>" By James Lamkin



There is something discombobulating about Easter. In fact, if the Gospel writers had known this word, the text would have read, "They left the empty tomb, hopeful, fearful, and discombobulated."

The word has a murky etymology. It showed-up in the 1830's and meant, "No longer having one's composure." Also, the *bob* in *discombobulate* may reference a *bobbin*, a reel of thread on a sewing machine. When things go smoothly, they are *combobulated*. But, when thread jumps the track and makes a mess...things are *discombobulated*.

I've been telling Liz that I was looking forward to living past Easter Sunday this year. Maybe then, I said, life for us will be <u>recombobulated</u> (and yes that is a real word). Ever since Easter Sunday 2018, life has been dense. Liz's mother died in April. Then, her beloved Uncle Jack died in July. Then, her only sibling, Phil, died in November. Plus, yo u watched me hobble around for three months with back and leg pain. (Even now, when I try to get off the floor after the Children's Sermon...don't look. You can't un-see it.)

Plus, we've gone through a long season of funeral services at the church...including Aunt Jane's! I thought Jane was indestructible. I was wrong.

A lot of life and death happens between Easters.

However, Liz and you and I have made it past Easter Sunday 2019. Yay! We are now in the 50 Great Days.

No need to "Make Easter Great Again." It is great, already. Easter's Good News is that the ongoing life and love of God meets us at life's sharp edges and profound graves. At Easter, God even raised-up Jesus to a new kind of "resurrection life and body." And, get this: God will do the same for us.
